Section X1721. Purpose.

The intent of this chapter is, that no Buildings or structures shall be left in a derelict state within the limits of the City of Gardiner, unless they meet one of the three conditions listed in this chapter.

Section X1722. Definitions.

A derelict building is any building or structure that is uninhabited, unused, vacant, or abandoned.

Section X1723. Acceptable reasons for a derelict state

A building or structure may remain in a derelict state if at least one of the following conditions is met:

- 1. The property is actively being marketed as for sale or for rent
- 2. The property is under renovation and has an active building permit with the City.
- 3. The property has been registered with the City as a Derelict building.

Section X1750. Registered Derelict Buildings

If the City finds that a building may stay a derelict building it will allow a building to be registered as a derelict building. For a yearly fee of \$250.00, a building may remain in a derelict state and the following conditions must be met:

- 1. The property must be secured against trespass and misuse.
- 2. The property must not pose a safety hazard.
- 3. The property must be Visible posted with a permit from the City giving the date of issuance and the contact for the Code Enforcement Office.
- 4. The property must be mowed and trimmed on a regular basis
- 5. The property must be free from debris and trash in the yard

Section X1751. Inspection

Any building registered as a Derelict building will be subject to regular inspections by the Code Enforcement officer or the police department. If an issue is found it must be corrected in a timely manner.

Section X1751. Penalties.

Any person found guilty of violating any provisions of this chapter shall be subjected to a penalty of not more than \$100.00 for each offense. Each day in which a violation is proved to exist shall constitute a separate offense under this section.
