# An Order Authorizing FY26 Tax Collection Dates, Interest Rates and Tax Club Program

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDINER, MAINE:

That **September 15, 2025** is the due date for collection of the first half of fiscal year 2026 property taxes with no penalty due, and **March 16, 2026** is the due date for collection of the second half of fiscal year 2026 property taxes with no penalty due.

That the interest will be set at 8.5% per annum and will accrue on outstanding balances as of September 16, 2025 and March 17, 2026.

That this order also authorizes the acceptance of payments using the Property Tax Club, and the acceptance of prepayments for taxes not yet committed, with 0% interest accrued.

# City of Gardiner Tax Clubs 2025/2026

All previous accounts must be paid in full before a tax club is issued, which consists of Real Estate and Personal Property tax bills.

No tax club will be issued after September 1, 2025.

Monthly payments shall be figured by dividing the total bill by nine (9) equal payments. Payments shall commence September 5, 2025 and be completed on May 5, 2026. Payments will be due on the fifth day of the month. Post marks will be accepted. Interest will not accrue as long as your account is paid monthly and on time.

If you fail to make your monthly payment you will be removed from the Tax Club and interest will be charged as though you were not a Tax Club member. Once a tax club member's benefit is removed, it cannot be reinstated until the next fiscal year.

Tax Clubs may include both Real Estate and Personal Property. It is the taxpayer's responsibility, prior to the September 5th deadline, to specify which bills they wish to include. Please do not assume this office is aware of each member's preference.

Tax Clubs are set up for individual accounts. It is the taxpayer's responsibility to set up individual clubs, prior to September 5th. Payment coupons will be issued to designate which accounts to apply payment too. Properties in escrow are excluded from Tax Clubs.

#### **EMERGENCY ORDER 2026-06**

# An Order Authorizing FY26 Tax Collection Dates, Interest Rates and Tax Club Program

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDINER, MAINE:

That **September 22, 2025** is the due date for collection of the first half of fiscal year 2026 property taxes with no penalty due, and **March 16, 2026** is the due date for collection of the second half of fiscal year 2026 property taxes with no penalty due.

That the interest will be set at 7.5% per annum and will accrue on outstanding balances as of September 23, 2025 and March 17, 2026.

That this order also authorizes the acceptance of payments using the Property Tax Club, and the acceptance of prepayments for taxes not yet committed, with 0% interest accrued.

\*This order is intended to override and supersede Council Order 2026-03, approved on June 18, 2025. The original order erroneously set the interest rate on delinquent taxes at 8.5%. The due date of the first payment of taxes is extended to September 22, 2025 to allow for the customary minimum of 30 days between issuance of tax bills and the corresponding due date.

\* This order is issued as an emergency order, under Article II, subsection 7 of the City Charter, taking effect immediately upon approval, in order to facilitate the timely execution of commitment and collection of FY 2026 property taxes.
